Presentation:	Antisera against whole serums are obtained by immunizing host animals with whole serum. This product is reddish transparent liquid, containing 0.03% Proclin300.
Description:	Prealbumin is called thyroxine protein, with a molecular weight of 54,000. It is synthesized by liver cells. In electrophoretic separation, it is often shown in front of albumin and has a short half-life of only about 1.9 days. Prealbumin has a higher sensitivity than albumin and transferrin when protein is malnourished and liver dysfunction occurs.
Storage:	Store at 4°C short term and -20°C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.
